1	WELCOME, MEMBERS PRESENT AND APOLOGIES	
	AC welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked people for attending. No apologies were noted. AC provided context for the meeting and an explanation of the vote and spend process, as well as a brief explanation of the current PTA financial situation and activity.	
2	VOTE ON SPEND	
	Outdoor Play and Learning (OPAL) sheds	
	Mrs Boon has requested money from the PTA to support the OPAL project. The cost of both sheds is £5207.90. The sheds will be used to house equipment for the project.	
	There was discussion around the cost and use of the sheds and how they might benefit all children at OLOL. Some parents felt that it was still not clear how all children would benefit from the initiative as they felt their children didn't usually participate in the activities typically associated with OPAL. There was also some discussion around other items of equipment that the PTA could provide for the project.	
	It was noted that the purchase had gone ahead before any vote or agreement on spend had taken place, and that this should not happen in the future.	
	With these points in mind the voting options and results were as follows:	
	 Pay the full amount for both sheds as a final contribution to the OPAL project.(7 votes) Pay for 1 shed and look at further possible contributions.(3 votes) No contribution to the OPAL project. (0 votes) 	
	The PTA has therefore voted to contribute the full amount of £5207.90 to the school to pay for the sheds and would like to move on to fundraising for other initiatives.
